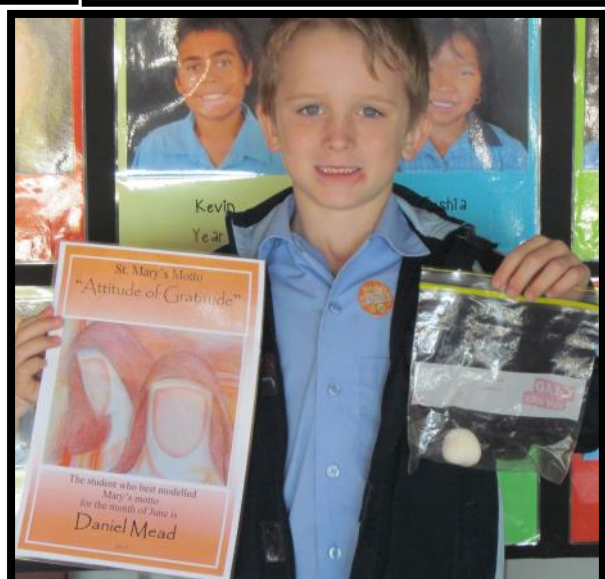

Our policy coincides with relevant State Health legislation and regulations.

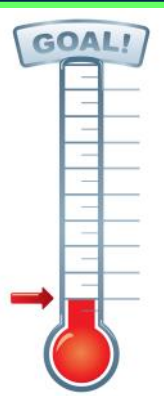
