Dear Parents and Carers,

This week Zalaë and Naomi attended the **Indigenous workshop** on the "Eight-way Framework for Indigenous Pedagogy". The ideas behind this include story sharing; seeing the whole then teaching the parts; repetition and returning to concepts brings deeper understanding; need for linking everything to land and their place; inclusion in community and with community; kinaesthetic and hands-on learning with a strong emphasis on body language and non-verbals; use of learning maps to map out thinking; and lastly, the use of images and metaphors for learning. Naomi and Zalaë also shared a Facebook post about their day. We look forward to the integration of ideas into our school practices.

The nomination process can be completed online on the awards page of the new [Catholic Education Week website](http://www.catholiceducationweek.org.au).

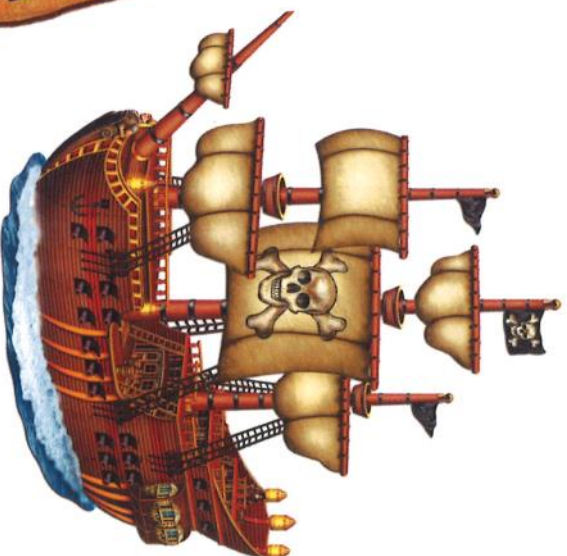

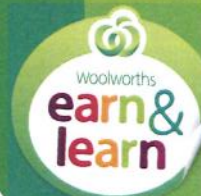

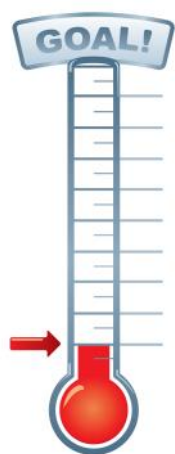
